STATIONERY REQUIREMENTS 2019

GRADE 8

All grade 8 stationery items are available at the KES Shop.

Items 1, 2 and 3 are COMPULSORY and can only be processed /paid in KES Shop

1 KES Grade 8 Stationery pack

Consists of essential stationery items needed - as stipulated by the Head of each Subject.

Contents of pack: pocket diary, exercise books, display files, portfolios, exam pads, file dividers, blue pen (2 of 4 requested by EMS), maths set, HB pencil, fineliner, pack of 12 felt tip markers, clutch pencil & lead, permanent marker and ruler

There are **2** different grade 8 stationery packs **depending on second language** , Afrikaans or isiZulu. Please mark which pack is required

2 KES Art Levy

This levy covers the cost of items which are used in class during the course of the year.

Once paid, boys will be issued a Grade 8 KES Art workbook. This book must be shown to the teacher to receive art materials.

3 KES Maths Study Programme Gr 8

This on- line tool enables learners to work on any computer, tablet or phone. Exercises are tailored to individual learners level and progress. Each learner works at own pace and level, with immediate feed back and explanations. The programme is overseen by the teacher and progress/ participation is monitored.

4 Calculator - Casio FX82 Scientific calculator

The Calculator is needed for Maths, EMS and Design Technology. It is NOT included in the Stationery pack but available from the School shop.

5 Book covers - There are 7 x A4 exercise books in the Gr 8 pack

Exercise books must be covered. Either with a PVC coloured book cover or plastic covered paper(brown or coloured paper).

6 Additional Stationery

There is also a small range of additional stationery available - e.g. coloured pens.
